The companies listed below successfully completed a review based on the PCI Data Security Standard as well as “3-D Secure Security Requirements – Enrollment and Access Control Servers version 1.1”.

The “VALIDATION DATE” is the date of last compliance. Reviews are valid for one year, with the next annual report due to Visa one year from the “VALIDATION DATE. Reports that are from 1-60 days late are noted in **yellow** and reports that are from 60-90 days late are noted in **red**. Entities with reports over 90 days past due will be removed from this list. If the date is **blue**, the current assessment has been submitted but not yet accepted. *It is the member's responsibility to use compliant service providers and to follow up with service providers if there are any questions about their compliance status.*
